DALFARRAS PROSECCO
– Goulburn River, Central Victoria

This Italian style sparkling wine delivers aromas of lemon, pear and tropical fruits. The mouthfeel is very nice with fresh acidity and fine bead structure to the bubbles within. The label depicting the Japonica Blossom is designed by Rosa Purbrick, wife of chief wine maker at Tahbilk Winery (Alister Purbrick). It's a quality drop under the flag of Tahbilk.

ZONZO ESTATE MOSCATO "DI MIA"
– Yarra Valley, Victoria

This is a refreshing sweet wine showing the flavours of ripe peach, nectarine and orange, balanced nicely with a hint of carbonation. It's made using a blend of Frontignan and Muscat Gordo Blanc to produce a wine which can be enjoyed on its own or with fruit based desserts.

LAWSONS DRY HILLS GEWURZTRAMINER - Marlborough, New Zealand

This example delivers some of the classic aromas associated with the grape variety; lychees, cardamom, lemon and rose petals. The taste profile provides an off dry style with a hint of sweetness balanced nicely by gentle acidity. At 14% ABV, the mouthfeel of this wine is round and rich.

PAULETTS RIESLING - Clare Valley, South Australia

Clare Valley is a premium Australian growing area for Riesling grapes. Examples from this climate often offer lemon, lime and stone fruit flavours. The acidity is lively and refreshing. This wine is a good reflection of this premium wine region.

TAHBILK PINOT GRIS - Nagambie Lakes, Central Victoria

This French inspired style is achieved by harvesting the grapes later which enables the appropriate ripeness. Aromas of nashi pear, green apple, and citrus zest combine nicely with a texture and acidity.

MOUNT VERNON SAUVIGNON BLANC - Marlborough, New Zealand

Under the label of Lawsons Dry Hills, this is a good example of a more restrained and less tropical style. Aromas of cut grass, lime zest, lemongrass and passionfruit lead into juicy citrus flavours on the palate and a crisp dry finish. DEVIL'S LAIR "THE HIDDEN CAVE"
CHARDONNAY
– Margaret River, Western Australia

Margaret River is well known for its world class chardonnay wines. This Chardonnay has aromas of white peach, lemon citrus and melon. There is subtle oak integration which provides creaminess and richness to the palate. Great with white meats, seafood and rich soft cheeses.

SAN PIETRO CHARDONNAY
– Mornington Peninsula, Victoria

The maritime effects of the Western Port Bay produce chardonnays which are more fruit driven with less acidity. This is the case here, with aromas of citrus and stone fruit and winemaker intervention using malolactic fermentation allows for a creamy palate.

SAN PIETRO PINOT NOIR
– Mornington Peninsula, Victoria

The maritime effects of the Western Port Bay also influence Pinot Noir grapes, producing wines which are more fruit driven with less acidity. This is the case here, with aromas of berry and forest floor and mouthfeel is chewy with creamy tannins.

FOX CREEK MERLOT
– McLaren Vale, South Australia

The McLaren Vale region is one of Australia's top producing areas for red wines. Relatively warm in climate, this merlot exhibits a bouquet of plums, raspberry and bright cherries with hints of dried herbs and oak. The palate is silky smooth with juiciness and exotic spices. The linear acidity running through the palate makes this wine versatile with food.

PREECE SHIRAZ
– Heathcote, Victoria

Heathcote represents a region from which some of Australia's best examples of shiraz are produced. The red soil unique to the area produces a fruit driven style, that is rich and smooth. The Preece shiraz offers a bouquet of licorice, blackberries, chocolate and spice. The palate is smooth with layers of plum, ripe blackberries and licorice. It's well balanced with soft tannins build and the finish has length.

PERTARINGA "UNDERCOVER" SHIRAZ –
McLaren Vale, South Australia

The McLaren Vale region is up there as one of Australia's famous and premium areas for growing shiraz grapes. Shiraz likes it warm and the region delivers plenty of it! You get rich, full big flavours, with notes of black cherry, chocolate, mocha and coffee bean. A red meat specialist.

BETHANY "FIRST VILLAGE" GSM
– Barossa Valley, South Australia

This is a medium bodied style which has its origins in the Rhone Valley in France. It's always a blend of Grenache, which contributes acidity and spiced red fruits; Syrah (shiraz), which provides tannin, colour and black pepper notes; and Mourvedre, which supports gamey or meaty flavours. It's silky smooth with a great mouth feel.

RESCHKE "BULL TRADER" CABERNET
MERLOT
– Coonawarra, South Australia

The blending of cabernet sauvignon and merlot is a well established and highly successful practice the world over. In the partnership, Merlot enhances the fruit flavours of the wine and gives a juicy mouthfeel, while Cabernet provides tannin, acidity and dark fruit flavours. The end result is a medium to full bodied wine that has it all! – blueberry and plum

TAHBILK CABERNET SAUVIGNON
– Nagambie Lakes, Central Victoria

A structured wine from one of the oldest family owned wineries in Australia. The estate is also certified as carbon neutral. This cabernet has aromas of intense blackberry, spice, black olive and dried herbs. The black olive character is unique to cabernet from that area. The palate is medium bodied and fresh, delivering flavours of blackcurrant and black olive. The wine has medium tannins and the finish is dry and long. Great with red meat dishes and hard cheeses. The oldest wine on the list.


